Annual Member have year-round access to stocked bass and catfish ponds.








By "show up and duck hunt" we mean that all duck hunters have to do is pull the trigger. We groom the ponds throughout the year, build and dress the blinds, plant hundreds of pounds of millet and rice and provide the decoys. Several blinds are a 5-minute walk from the lodge.


- ✓ A Texas Parks & Wildlife Texas Prairie Wetlands and Ducks Unlimited project, Camp Orion's 9 ponds are carefully managed to attract multiple duck species. Active management of the duck habitat Integrates almost 20 years of on-property experience and includes planting of hundred of pounds of millet and rice seed every year.
- ✓ 1.5 miles of cleared bayou shoreline offers a great venue for hunting wood ducks on the bayou, camping, fishing and just exploring.
- ✓ Our 3-acre bass pond, catfish pond behind the cabin and bayou frontage offer a yearround fishing amenity and additional native waterfowl habitat.
- Camp Orion maintains the ducky habitat, blinds and decoys. Members just show up with their gun, license and waders and hunt. Annual Members may also bring their own container to store personal UTVs and gear.



In addition to 6 bedrooms, each with a full bath and 2-4 beds, the lodge is appointed with trophy taxidermy, including many ducks harvested from Camp Orion. The two-story stone fire place anchors the gathering space.




In addition to a first-class stainless steel and granite kitchen and dining area to seat 16, the first floor of the lodge offers billards, a wet bar and several tables for enjoying card games. Our 3-acre bass pond was designed and stocked by Kenneth Henneke. It is well stocked with Texas bigmouth bass, blue gill and plenty of tasty minnows.





For the more adventuresome, Camp Orion receives several gator tags per year. Annual Members may participate in the lottery for tags and possibly add to their boot collection!



Camp Orion will never have more than 8 annual memberships. Renewing annual members enjoy a discounted membership fee if renewed in the following February. For 2021-2022, we have three annual memberships available.

Annual Memberships include use of the cabin during the access period and participation in Camp Orion's family events as well as level-specific privileges.


